

Safety Town - Level I

Children learn the rules of home, school, and outdoor safety through games, films, music, and guest speakers. They also learn about traffic, bicycle and pedestrian safety by driving trikes through Safety Town, a miniature village set up at Olympic Park's outdoor site. The Park District provides the trikes, which accommodate children of various heights and weights. Through creative play the children also learn how to board, ride, and exit a bus safely. Level I is open to 4 to 6 year olds entering kindergarten or first grade in the fall. Children need to be at least 5 years old by September 1, 2011. Meet in the lower level inside Olympic Park on the first day of the session. This is a cooperative program with Arlington Heights Park District. **All Safety Town participants should bring a labeled bike helmet, a labeled water bottle, and a backpack each day.**

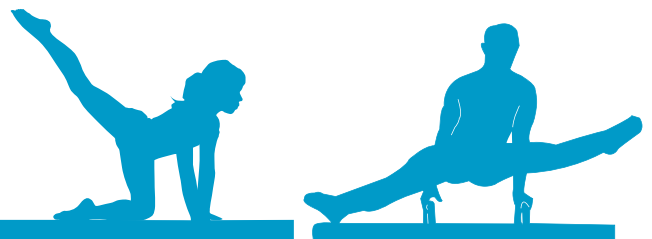

Streetwise storytellers pull the audience at breakneck speed toward the moon-drenched conclusion.

Learn the basics of performing, with an emphasis on acting. This session will provide young and aspiring actors to work on a production of Shakespeare's, "A Midsummer Night's Dream", especially adapted for this age group. Attendance is required at each class. 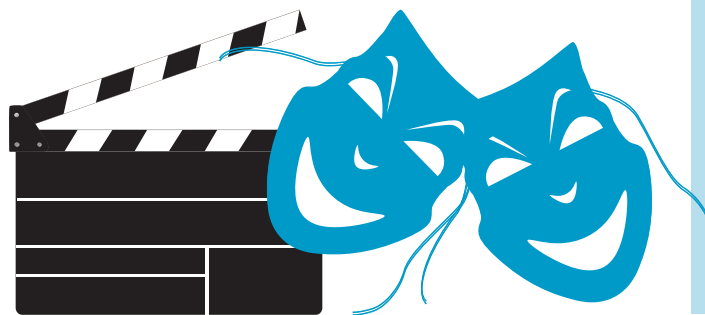

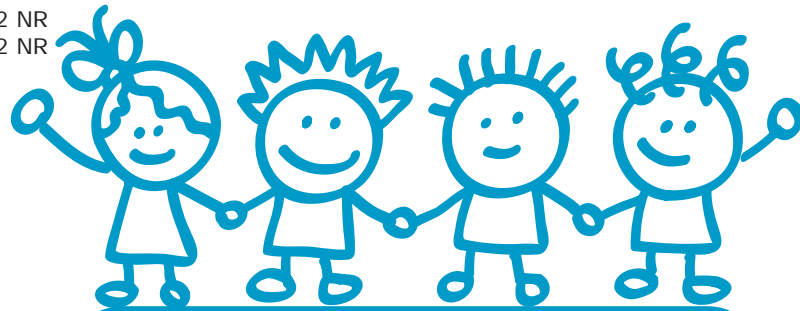
