PLEASE NOTE: Palatine Youth Baseball/Softball is organized and governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. The Board of Directors raises funds to supplement registration fees to offset the expenses associated with Palatine Youth Baseball/Softball. Occasionally expenses are incurred which are not previously approved by Park District staff or by the Board of Park Commissioners. Occasionally, Palatine Youth Baseball/Softball organizational positions are taken relative to Park District issue and/or Park Board candidates which may not represent the views of the Park Board and/or individual commissioners.

Palatine Youth Baseball/Softball Serving Palatine children thru 6th grade

- We are run exclusively by volunteers as an affiliate of the Palatine Park District.
- Approximately 1,800 participants in 2009, which makes it the most popular league in Palatine by a wide margin.
- Baseball and Softball Leagues based on grade for children age 5 (as of 8/31/10) thru present 6th graders (during 2009-2010 school year).
- Only program in Palatine for girls 1st grade thru 6th grade to play fast pitch softball.
- Post Season Travel Teams are formed for 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 year old boys and U8, U10 and U12 girls softball.
- Early Bird Registration Discount available thru January 10, 2010.
- Registration closes for Competitive Leagues on February 28, 2010. Do not wait until the last minute. This program is so successful that there aren't sufficient fields to enable us to accept all interested children.
- Non-Competitive Leagues (Kindergarten thru 1st Grade Boys, Kindergarten thru 2nd Grade Girls) registration closes on March 14, 2010. This program is so successful that there aren't sufficient fields to enable us to accept all interested children.
- Uniforms include Major League Baseball and NCAA Division 1 replica shirts and hat/visors.
- Play will begin early April 2009 and conclude around the 4th of July.
- End of Year Celebration (PYB/S Baseball and Softball Day) will be July 10, 2010. The day includes All Star Games, Trophy Ceremonies, and Interactive Displays from Baseball/Softball related vendors.
