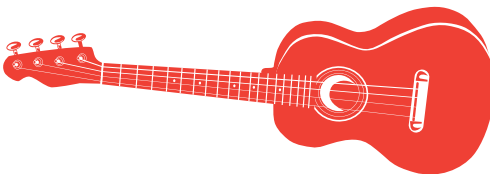
Instant Guitar for Hopelessly Busy Adults & Teens

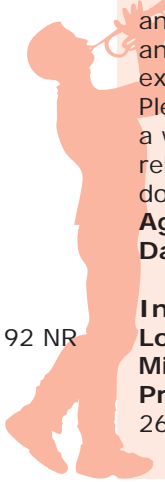


Palatine Area Community Marching Band
