Our singers from throughout the northwest suburbs enjoy a variety of musical experiences in the Sing with Me (ages 4-5), Do Re Mi (ages 6-7), Treble (age 8+), Intermezzo, Concert, and Honors Choirs. The Chorus safely nurtures children's voices, introduces all age groups to a variety of music, and offers each level appropriate music instruction. Our traveling choirs have performed at New York's famed Carnegie Hall (1999), Niagara Falls, Montreal, and Quebec in Canada (1997 and 2003), throughout Great Britain (2001), in Hawaii (2005), Austria and Venice (2007), San Francisco (2008), and renowned Ryman Auditorium in Nashville (2010). They have also performed for the Chicago Cubs, Chicago White Sox, Joffrey Ballet, at Lincoln Park Zoo, and at the Illinois State Fair, as well as many local Palatine-area venues. December concerts will be held on December 7 and 10 at Cutting Hall.

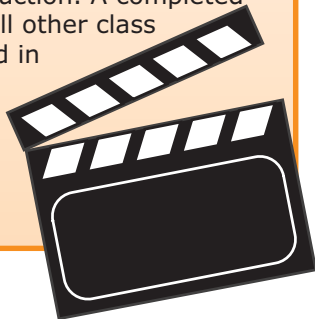

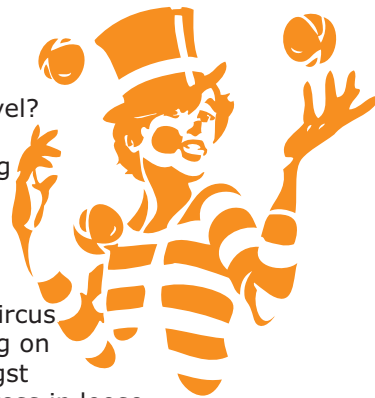
