Re: Award of Bid; Community Park and Ost Field Lighting

**Recommendation**

**& Motion:** That the Board of Park Commissioners approve, the lowest responsible bidder Musco Sports Lighting of Batavia, Illinois in the amount not to exceed \$810,000 for the purchase and installation of sports field lighting for two fields at Community Park and Ost field.

**Rationale:** This purchase and installation will be made through the Sourcewell (formerly NJPA) cooperative purchasing program. This is a 2018 budgeted item for the replacement of sports field lighting that was originally installed at Community Park in 1984 and on Ost Field sometime during the high school era. Staff originally investigated the potential of only replacing the light fixtures, but engineering studies determined that the poles would not support the new light fixtures. This price is turn key and includes a twenty-five-year product assurance warranty program that covers materials and onsite labor, eliminating 100% of maintenance costs for twenty-five years. Jasco Lighting has been contracted by Musco Lighting to perform the installation of the underground electric, poles, fixtures and cabinets for the project. Jasco is a very reliable company that has completed many similar projects in the northwest suburbs and Palatine Park District electrical projects with a high degree of success.

The project will be \$10,500 over budget when soft costs are factored in. A portion of the over budget costs relates to additional electrical installation requested by staff to install new lines to the shelter and fusing required by code. The over budget cost will be taken from the under-budget funding from the 2018 Playground Installation Project. Additionally, a Com Ed grant has been applied for to offset some of the cost. The price quotes and scope of work are included.
