## **Open Space**

The District owns 439.6 acres of land and leases an additional 295.6 acres from various agencies including the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District. The District operates and maintains over 50 parks and over ten miles of paved paths. There are numerous soccer, baseball/softball, and multi-use fields located throughout the district including outdoor turf fields at Celtic Park.



## Golf

Palatine Hills Golf Course is a 6,800 yard, par 72 championship course with six sets of tees that provide a challenging yet enjoyable experience for golfers of all skill levels. Practice facilities at Palatine Hills include the Short Course, driving range, and putting green. Tee times available at palatinehills.org.



### Fitness

Palatine Park District built a new outdoor fitness pad with 10 pieces of equipment at Robert "Dutch" Schultz Recreation Area near the golf course. The equipment, located on the Palatine Trail, is free and open for public use. Additional fitness equipment will be added along the trail in coming years. Indoor fitness opportunities are offered at Community Fitness Center.





### **Basketball**



## Pools

Palatine Park District has three outdoor pools including Birchwood Pool, Eagle Pool, and Family Aquatic Center. Palatine Park District also manages the indoor pool at Harper College's Health and Recreation Center, offering indoor aquatic programs and classes year-round.






# TO RECREATION

## Pickleball

With the recent opening of six new outdoor pickleball courts with lights at Hamilton Reservoir, the District now offers 10 outdoor courts for pickleball play. In addition, indoor pickleball is offered at Birchwood Recreation Center, Falcon Park Recreation Center, and Health and Recreation Center at Harper College.







## Playgrounds

The District maintains 30 playgrounds throughout its 50 parks and renovates up to 2 playgrounds each year. Community Park and Lindberg Park offer the Biba Playground Games, a combination of digital and physical play options on the equipment in the playground. For information on playgrounds being renovated please check palatineparks.org.

## **Specialty Parks**

Palatine Park District offers several specialty parks. A free skate park and a free 18-hole disc golf course are located at Riemer Reservoir. Membership information for the Dog Park at Plum Grove Reservoir is available at palatineparks.org.

## Tennis

There are 14 tennis courts maintained by Palatine Park District, offering free court time for all. Courts are located at Birchwood Park, Community Park, Eagle Park, Locust Park, Schultz Recreation Area, and Sycamore Park.

## Volleyball

Outdoor sand volleyball courts are located at Community Park and Oak Park. In addition, indoor open volleyball is offered at various times at Community Center and Falcon Park Recreation Center.

## Walking in Palatine

The District offers a variety of walking options including over ten miles of paved pathways that are part of Palatine Trail. These paths include loops around Birchwood South Park, Hamilton Reservoir/Gbur Fields and at Falcon Park. An outdoor ¼ mile walking track is located at Ost Field, and indoor walking tracks are located at Community Center (14 laps=1mile) and Falcon Park Recreation Center (12 laps=1mile).

## **Guidelines for All Users**

- Stay to the right on the trail
- · Give warning before passing on the left
- Move off the trail when stopped
- Obey all stop signs
- Wear bright or reflective clothing Motorized vehicles are prohibited



## **VILLAGE OF PALATINE BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

In 2016, the Village of Palatine added a variety of bicycle-related improvements to village roads as part of ongoing implementation of the Village's Bicycle Transportation Plan adopted in 2011. Riders, runners, walkers, and drivers should make themselves familiar with these Bike Route and Bike Lane improvements:

## Bike Route Type 1

- A C Quiet residential streets with little to no on-street parking.
- Low traffic volumes
- · Designated by green Bike Route signs, no pavement markings.

## Bike Route Type 2

- Streets with no parking, no bike lane, and high traffic counts.
- Designated by green Bike Route SHARE signs, Share the Road signs, and bicycle pavement markings (sharrows).

## **Bike Route Type 3**

• Streets with parking, with higher traffic counts; usually a divided road.

- Designated by shared bike/ parking signs, green Bike Route signs, solid white line seven feet from curb, bicycle markings (sharrows) outside the shared lane.
- Riders will ride outside the bike lane when cars occupy the shared parking area.

## Bike Lane

Streets that prohibit parking that are also wide enough to accommodate the required width for both vehicular and bicycle lanes.


